The Power of Faith

1. The vision that drives us is to see the lives of lost, hurting, and broken people experience the transforming love of God. *Romans 5:6-11 NLT*
2. The vision that compels us to take steps of faith is to have the opportunity to sow and build the Word of God into the lives of people. *Matthew 7:24-29 NKJV*
3. The vision that moves us to take steps of faith is to assist people in discovering their destiny and grow in the character of Jesus Christ. *Ephesians 2:10 NLT*
4. The vision that inspires us to take steps of faith is to have a base to reach out from to the nations of the world with the life-changing power of God. *Psalms 2:8 NLT*
5. The vision that causes us to take steps of faith is to be a group of people who care deeply about the spiritual condition of people in our sphere of influence. *Luke 15:1-7 NLT*
6. We cannot accomplish God's plan for our lives without taking steps of faith.
7. Faith is a persuasion – a conviction based upon the Word of God.
8. Faith is a belief and trust in and loyalty to God.
9. Faith is a firm belief in something in which there is no physical or seen proof.
10. Our proof is the Word of God and what we hear the Holy Spirit saying to us to do. *Hebrews 11:1 AMP*
11. Every step of faith is a journey with God.

13. Faith in God has a sincere attitude and hunger within it.
14. Faith is like a muscle – opposition may strain it, but at the end it grows stronger.
15. Our human nature always wants to cling to the familiar and return to the safety of yesterday.
16. What do we do when we feel cornered by the circumstances of life? We put our faith deeper in God. *2 Chronicles 20:17 NLT*
17. Faith is what empowers us to live in victory in spite of the problems of life. *Mark 5:23-34 NLT*
18. Her hearing about Jesus put faith in her heart.
19. Her faith put a hunger in her for action.
20. She didn't let her circumstances stop her.
21. Her sincere faith connected with the power of God in Jesus.
22. Jesus called her daughter, which let her know His love for her.
23. Her active faith in Jesus was very significant in her receiving her healing.
